New Jersey Unclaimed Property is providing this reminder of your obligation to report, pay and/or deliver abandoned property to the State Treasurer.

The Unclaimed Personal Property Report must be filed before November 1, 2011 for property presumed abandoned as of June 30, 2011. Failure to meet this requirement will result in statutory interest and penalties.
